

NYS Behavioral Health (BH) Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) and Community Oriented Recovery and Empowerment (CORE) Dashboard: County Level Data

The below references information found in the Data table entitled “HCBS/CORE Access Data by County Fiscal Responsibility”

This data set provides a snapshot of the number of individuals who have completed significant steps toward utilizing NYS Adult Behavioral Health (BH) Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) and Community Oriented Recovery and Empowerment (CORE). The data is breakout by County and updated on a quarterly basis.

All data is unique recipient data meaning that Individuals are counted only once.

BH HCBS assessment data has approximately a one-week lag. Based on assessment records (UAS), this data set captures the number of individuals who have completed one or more assessments, and not the number of total assessments.
7	Recipients Received HCBS/CORE in Past 12 Months	Medicaid Data Warehouse (MDW)	Number of individuals by county who have received BH HCBS or CORE as determined by having at least one paid BH HCBS or CORE service claims within last 12 months (without claim-lag). Individuals with multiple service claims are only counted once.	BH HCBS assessment claims and provider travel supplemental claims are not included in this data set. The months that still impacted by claim-lag are excluded. For example, the dashboard updated at May 2020 includes all recipients who has least one service claim during Feb 2019-Jan 2020.

Health Home Enrolled(Column F) includes all enrollees as of 07/01/2023

HCBS Assessed in Past 12 Months and HCBS/CORE Claimed in Past 12 Months columns(Column G and H) includes all recipients between 07/01/2022 and 07/01/2023

HCBS Assessed (Column G) only includes assessed population enrolled in HARP or HIV SNP.

Out of all HARP members who have been assessed in the past 12 months, 96% were determined eligible for either Tier 1 or Tier 2 HCBS services.
