## Introduction

Recovery Plus North Tonawanda Recovery and Treatment Center is a clinic service that provides a broad range of mental health services to meet the needs of adults with a diagnosis of mental illness.

We take a person-centered holistic approach to recovery. We are not just treating an illness. Rather, we work with individuals to rebuild a foundation which will sustain lasting recovery and an improved quality of life.

Our goal is to remove barriers to recovery and wellness, building on inherent personal strengths and natural supports in the surrounding community.

## Our Services

We provide supportive programming in the areas of individual, group, and family counseling; medication management and education; skill building; and health and wellness.

We offer individual and group trauma counseling.

Vocational services can provide a path to recovering a life role as a worker. We assist individuals with applying for entitlement programs, enrolling in GED and other educational programs, building resumes, developing job readiness skills, researching volunteer opportunities, and re-entering the workforce.

Connections to other community resources are provided as needed.
