- Settlement agreements between NYS and several companies
- Components of the settlement agreements
 - Direct payments from Attorney General's Office
 - NYC, Long Island, other localities
 - State funds
 - Opioid Settlement Advisory Board (\$128M)
 - Regional abatement (\$64M)
