


## Who Will Benefit?

## Our Services

We assist individuals with applying for entitlement programs, enrolling in GED and other educational programs, building resumes, developing job readiness skills, researching volunteer opportunities, and re-entering the workforce.

Connections to other community resources are provided as needed.

Miller-Broadway RTC is located at 1384 Broadway Ave., a few blocks east of the Broadway Market. We are open from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday-Friday. Our telephone is 894-9672. Rapid access (walk-in) services are available.

After hours support is available seven days a week by calling our main number, 894-9672. Your call will be automatically forwarded to Crisis Services Inc. counselors who can provide needed assistance. Our staff will provide outreach and followup the next business day.

The site is handicapped accessible, and is on public transportation routes.
