Dear Health Plan Administrators,

Effective January 1, 2023 and April 1, 2023, the mental health outpatient service rates have been increased to reflect a legislatively mandated Minimum Wage Increase and a 4% Cost-Of-Living Adjustment (COLA) respectively, which is consistent with the 2022-23 and 2023-24 Enacted State Budget and will be reflected in premiums upon State and Federal approvals. This letter is being sent to alert Mainstream Medicaid Managed Care Plans, Health and Recovery Plans, HIV Special Needs Plans, and Medicaid Advantage Plus Plans (collectively referred to as "MMCPs" herein), of the adjustments to ensure compliance with the statutorily required payment of government rates.

- Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)
- State Operated Continuing Day Treatment (CDT)
- Non-State Operated Continuing Day Treatment (CDT)

- Partial Hospitalization (PH)
- Personalized Recovery Oriented Services (PROS)
- Mental Health Outpatient Treatment Rehabilitation Services (MHOTRS) under APGs
- Community Oriented Recovery and Empowerment (CORE) Services
- Adult Behavioral Health Home and Community Based Services (BH HCBS)

- Mobile Crisis Services for children under 21 years old²
- Crisis Residential Services for children under 21 years old²

Per Chapter 57 of the Laws of 2022, MMCPs are required to pay claims based on the effective date of the rate changes. As a result, MMCPs must complete necessary systems edits to ensure payable claims for dates of service January 1, 2023 and thereafter for ACT, CDT, CPEP, PH, PROS, and MHOTRS; and April 1, 2023 and thereafter for ACT, CDT, CPEP, PH, PROS, MHOTRS, CORE Services, Adult BH HCBS, and Mobile Crisis and Crisis Residential Services for Children under 21 years old, are reimbursed at the newly effective rates. Additionally, MMCPs are required to conduct retrospective reconciliation to adjust payment for clean claims as necessary.
