

Referral (includes clinical information) sent to SPOA for access to intensive mental health services (TCM, Waiver, CR, FBT, RTF) by family a/o provider

SPOA completes Child and Youth Needs and Strengths (CANS) assessment

SPOA Committee determines level (LOC) of care based on clinical information, CANS assessment and planning efforts with family

If LOC is determined to be TCM, Waiver, CR, or FBT, referral is forwarded to respective provider whose representative is a member of the SPOA Committee.

If LOC is determined to be RTF, referral is forwarded to the Regional PACC Committee

If a youth's needs can best be met by services from another system, referral is forwarded to systems' representative who is a member/liaison to the SPOA

If youth is placed on the wait list, SPOA monitors

If youth is placed on wait list, PACC monitors with periodic updates from the SPOA

SPOA committee liaison updates SPOA committee periodically on status of youth
