

Change to Recipient Search – Individual Search and Group Search Menus:

In the drop down menu “Maximum No. Of Rows to be displayed” (which allows a user to select the number of rows to be included in the search results), an entry of 10,000 has been added. This will facilitate a search that will yield a large list of recipient names (maximum 10,000). This replaces the “All” entry.

Page numbering functionality has been added. When the number of rows exceeds the amount displayed on a screen, page numbers appear at the bottom of each page of the results. A user can click on a page number to advance to another screen containing results.

Changes to the Clinical Summary:

A new user feature, “Quality Flag Help,” has been added to the Clinical Summary, which can be accessed by clicking on the question mark icon, located on the far right of the “Indicator Set”/“Quality Flag Evidence” header row. The “Quality Flag Help” pop-up table contains each indicator and its description. A user can scroll through the table to view the indicators/definitions or search for a specific quality indicator using the search box in the upper right corner of the table. An “Export to PDF” icon located on the lower right corner can be used to export the indicators/definitions to a PDF.

In the “Rx Detail for Medication” tables in the Medications sections (Behavioral Health and Medical), a “Total Daily Dose*” column has been added (this table is displayed by clicking the “See All Data” tab). Hover the cursor over the asterisk for an explanation of “Total Daily Dose” (“Tabs per day X Strength”).

Changes to Mapping:

In the Mapping screen’s filters, selecting an indicator from the “Indicator Set” drop-down menu now carries over to all QI Overview screens for “Region,” “County,” “Network,” “Provider,” and “Plan” tabs.

To enhance readability in the Plan tab table, the following columns have been deleted: Region, Region%, County, County %.

For state level users: Page number functionality has been added to the “Prescriber” and “Provider Attending” tabs in Mapping. When the number of “Prescriber” or “Provider Attending” names exceeds the amount displayed on a screen, page numbers appear at the bottom of each page of the results. A user can click on a page number to advance to another screen containing results.

Changes to the Registrar Menu:

For state level users: Under the Registrar Menu, the Medicaid Consent sub-menu has been deleted.
