

## Changes to Screen Header Tabs:

The screen header tabs at the top of each PSYCKES screen have been reordered; some have been renamed. The display of the tabs and/or available functionality are dependent on user type. The tabs appear in this order:

- My QI Report (new tab to quickly access your QI report)
- Statewide Reports (new name for Mapping)
- Recipient Search
- Provider Search (previously accessed through "Provider Reports")
- MyPSYCKES (displayed for state level users and providers participating in MyPSYCKES)
- Registrar Menu (displayed for PSYCKES Registrars and state level users)
- Usage Report

## Change to the Clinical Summary:

Near the top of the Clinical Summary in the Report Header, the column heading "Quality Flag Evidence" is now "Quality Flags (as of monthly QI report [date])."

## Changes to the Usage Reports:

In the "Usage Details" section of the PSYCKES Usage Report, the results still sort by "User Status as of End of Report Period" (e.g., Active, Inactive, Never Accessed), but now sort alphabetically by last name within the these status categories.

In the Clinical Summaries Viewed screen, the search field for "User Name (First & Last)" now auto-populates on the last name when at least three letters of the user's last name are entered.

## Changes to the Registrar Menu:

For agency level users: Under the "Administration" tab of the Registrar Menu, these changes were made on the "Add/Edit Provider Information for Consent Form" screen.

- The field name, "Name of Provider/Hospital/Clinic (Max. 65 Characters.);" was changed to "Name of Provider." The "Name of Provider" field is now auto-populated with the provider's name as it appears in the Medicaid database, and it is not editable.
- The other fields remain editable. Data entered into these fields are saved after clicking "Submit" and can be updated as needed.

## Statewide Reports (previously "Mapping"):

In the table section of "Statewide Reports," the word "STATE" is now a hyperlink, and directs the user to the Statewide QI Overview report.

In the table section, a new entity has been added under "Network": OMH STATE PC NETWORK. A user can drill down to review data for state operated psychiatric centers.

## **State Level users:**

After login, the default screen for state level users is a newly created Statewide QI Overview report (also accessed from other screens by clicking on “My QI Report”).
