PSYCKES-Medicaid Release Notes – Release 7.7.1

Prescription Drug Prior Authorization in Recipient Search & Clinical Summary

On April 1, 2023 the pharmacy benefit shifted from Medicaid Managed Care to the Medicaid Fee for Service (FFS) pharmacy program, NYRx. Individuals enrolled in a Mainstream plan, HARP, or HIV SNP who are prescribed a medication not on the NYRx preferred drug list, and who do not have an existing Medicaid Managed Care Plan (MMCP) prior authorization, will need to either switch medications or receive NYRx prior authorization. A new filter checkbox will be added to Recipient Search and a message will display in the Clinical Summary for individuals who have one or more prescription medications requiring NYRx prior authorization.
