# What is PSYCKES?

- A web-based application that uses Medicaid claims data to support:
  - Clinical decision-making
  - Quality improvement
- Has been used in State Psychiatric Centers and free-standing mental health clinics; now expanding to hospital-based mental health clinics and Emergency Rooms

# Who is in the PSYCKES Database?

- Medicaid enrollees
  - Fee-for-service
  - Managed care
- Mental health consumers, i.e., at least one of the following in the past year:
  - Mental Health Service
  - Mental health diagnosis
  - Psychotropic medication (newly expanded to include this group)
- Currently over 2.5 million individuals

# What Client Information Is in the PSYCKES Database?

- Medicaid claims data across treatment settings
  - Mental health (outpatient and inpatient)
  - Medical (services, lab tests, and procedures)
  - Pharmacy (psychotropic and medical)
- Up to five years of data
- Medicaid-billable services for which a claim was submitted
  - For dual-eligible clients (Medicare and Medicaid), includes services but not pharmacy

# Access to Client-Level Data in PSYCKES

- Provided without consent for Medicaid enrollees...
  - Positive for any quality concern tracked in PSYCKES
  - At least one billed service anywhere in your hospital/agency in past 9 months
- Rationale: Federal mandate to monitor the safety and effectiveness of Drug Utilization in Medicaid
- Does not include Personal Health Information (PHI) with special protections
  - Substance abuse
  - HIV
  - Genetic information
  - Reproductive / family planning

# Coming Soon: PSYCKES Consent Module

- Access to client-level data
  - with consent from the consumer
  - In clinical emergencies (limited to 72 hours)
- Expanded access
  - Includes all Medicaid enrollees (including those not positive for a quality concern and those not yet associated with agency/hospital through billing)
  - Includes PHI with special protections
- Still in preliminary stages; being piloted at a few sites

# Advantages of PSYCKES Data

- Represents large number of consumers
- Data available at levels of state, region, agency/hospital, prescriber and client
- Client-level data is comprehensive
  - Refreshed weekly
  - Pharmacy data especially robust
- Built-in quality improvement tools
- HIPAA-compliant

# Limitations of PSYCKES Data

- Accuracy dependent on coding and billing
- Data elements limited to what is shown on claims
  - e.g., see labs/tests but without results
- Data with special protections not usually included
- Client data affected by hospitalizations (bundled services), loss of Medicaid coverage, moves.
- Time lag between services and billing is variable
  - Pharmacy data timely; billed at time of pick-up
  - Service data may lag by weeks or months

## [FEDERAL MEDICAID CONFIDENTIALITY STANDARDS:](#)

The Federal Medicaid confidential data standard is established by §1902(a)(7) of the Social Security Act (42 USC §1396a(a)(7)). The law requires that a "State plan for medical assistance must: (7) provide safeguards which restrict the use or disclosure of information concerning applicants and recipients to purposes directly connected with the administration of the plan." This statutory requirement is implemented in regulations at 42 CFR §431.300 et seq.. 42 CFR §431.302 defines Medicaid program administration to include:

- (A) Establishing Eligibility;
- (B) Determining the amount of Medical Assistance;
- (C) Providing services for recipients; and
- (D) Conducting or assisting an investigation, prosecution, or civil or criminal proceeding related to the administration of the plan.

42 C.F.R. §431.306 requires the single state agency to have criteria specifying the conditions for release and use of information about applicants and recipients. The information for which the agency must have criteria to safeguard must include: (1) names and addresses; (2) medical services provided; (3) social and economic conditions; (4) agency evaluation of personal information; (5) medical data, including diagnosis and past history of disease or disability; and (6) any information received for verifying income eligibility and amount of medical

# Limitations of PSYCKES Data: Linking Clients to Prescribers and Programs

- Clients may not be linked accurately to prescribers
  - Psychiatrist listed as “Attending” for billed service on Medicaid claims is linked to client
  - Residents and other providers not linked to client
  - Hospitals may bill for multiple services, so claims may show attending from different service
- Clients may not be linked accurately to specific program in your agency/hospital
  - Clients linked to program for 9 months after last bill, regardless if seen regularly or just once.
  - Billing practices may combine multiple programs/sites

# Most Accurate Links between Clients and Providers

- Clients are very accurately linked to providers at the agency/hospital level
  - Based upon tax ID number of payee
  - Confidentiality of PHI is maintained
- Search by program type (e.g., Clinic) is generally accurate and comprehensive
  - Includes all programs of same type
  - Likely to be over-inclusive; unlikely to be missing data
- Can be used if search by prescriber does not yield comprehensive information

# Click Path: Clinic List of Positive Cases

- Start at agency QI summary
- Select “Clinic” under program type → page refreshes
- Click on the applicable quality concern → new page
- Click on “Summary” → see tab: unduplicated recipients
- Then, same as above:
  - Click on client’s name → see Clinical Summary
  - Click on desired time period → page refreshes
  - Review client data






