

Home and Community-Based Waiver Services (HCBS) Individualized Care Coordination Program Rider

As a provider of HCBS, a strong collaborative relationship between the Local Government Unit (LGU) and the Individualized Care Coordination Agency (ICC) is required to complement the existing county service system in a manner that fits local culture, including recruitment policies that help meet the cultural and linguistic needs of the program population. As the lead agency for the HCBS Waiver, the ICC Agency must meet the requirements as outlined in the Children's HCBS Waiver Guidance document which can be found on <http://www.omh.ny.gov/omhweb/guidance/hcbs/>.
